### **Solutions for the FULRO Problem in Tay Nguyen - Viewing From the Leadership of the Communist Party of Vietnam (1975-1988)**

**Abstract:** Tay Nguyen is an important strategic area of Vietnam in terms of economic development, national defense and security. Therefore, hostile forces always find ways to take advantage of this area to carry out countermeasures. Initially, the movement against the dictatorship of Ngo Dinh Diem of ethnic minorities in the South of Vietnam since 1958 was in turn taken advantage of by forces opposing Vietnam, turning it into a dangerous reactionary organization - FULRO. After liberation, to solve the problem of FULRO, the CPV advocated to set out appropriate guidelines and methods of tackling it, in which the CPV creatively applied the method of changing from "armed struggle" to "combining political struggle with arms".

At the same time, there is close coordination between the forces in Tay Nguyen, creating synergy to solve the problem of FULRO. Since then, the "post-war plan" and the "multi-faceted destructive war" of the hostile forces have failed. In this article, the authors focus on clarifying the results of solving the FULRO problem in Tay Nguyen and the achievements and limitations in leading and directing the fight against FULRO. From there, we point out some of the Party's leadership experiences in solving the FULRO problem in Tay Nguyen from 1975 to 1988, which can become valuable lessons for today.

**Abstract:** A destination's image strongly influences tourists in deciding whether to choose or revisit a destination. This paper researched and analysed international tourists' up-to-date assessments of Vietnam's destination image through electronic word-of-mouth on social networking sites from

March 2022 – two years after the COVID-19 pandemic and the time Vietnam officially opened again to international tourists. The author conducts a survey and collects opinions from international tourists' comments about Vietnam destination image on the three largest tourist-used social

networking platforms, including Facebook, Youtube, and Instagram (as reported by Statista, 2021). The research results show that most international tourists identify the image of Vietnam on the factors of scenic beauty with beautiful beaches; hospitable local people with diverse cultures; delicious food and coffee; cheap cost of living, and

convenient transportation. There are a few common problems, including traffic chaos, flooding, and environmental pollution and the most recent problem is with the duration of the tourist visa.

## Childhood Abuse Experiences and Depression in High School Students: A Cross-sectional Study

**Abstract:** This research studies the relationship between childhood abuse experiences and depression in high school students. There were 586 students in 4 schools in Bac Giang with mean age of 16,02 (SD = 0,87) that completed the Adverse Childhood Experiences Questionnaire Abuse Short Form (ACE-ASF) and Children's Depression Inventory (CDI). The survey results indicated that there are 328 students (56,0%) who experienced childhood abuse, with

emotional abuse being the most frequent type (44,7%) while sexual abuse being the least frequent (8,0%) and females reported a higher prevalence of emotional abuse than males ( $p < 0,01$ ). Types of childhood abuse experience were positively correlated from low to medium with depression in students. Several recommendations for practice and research were also discussed.
